ROPSSAA SPECIAL EVENT BOWLING

PLAYING REGULATIONS

1. DATE

(a) Season – The tournament(s) to be held during the January exam break.

2. LOCATION

(a) Tournament(s) to be held at bowling alleys in Brampton and Mississauga.

3. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>

(a) Competitors must meet age and year of high school requirements.

4. OPERATING STRUCTURE

(a) Schools will be assigned to a tournament upon confirmation of intent to participate forms.

5. <u>ENTRIES</u>

- (a) Each school may enter competitors in either assisted or unassisted competition. The assisted category is for those individuals requiring a ramp and bumpers. The unassisted category is for those individuals requiring bumpers only.
- (b) Bowlers in the unassisted category may request to bowl without bumpers.

6. <u>EXPENSES</u>

- (a) Participating schools will provide their own transportation.
- (b) Participating schools to cover their own bowling game costs.

7. RULES AND OFFICIALS

- (a) Games will involve 10 pin bowling.
- (c) Participants to register their best game results for scoring purposes. Schools are to report the best score from a single game only.
- (d) The top 5 scores per school in the assisted category to be tabulated to determine the top team.
- (e) The top 5 scores per school in the unassisted category to be tabulated to determine the top team.

8. UNIFORMS

(a) Participants must wear footwear as determined by the bowling alley.

9. Awards

- (a) Gold medals to be presented to the first place finishers in the boys assisted, girls assisted, boys unassisted and girls unassisted categories.
- (b) Silver medals to be presented to the second place finishers in the boys assisted, girls assisted, boys unassisted and girls unassisted categories.
- (c) Bronze medals to be presented to the third place finishers in the boys assisted, girls assisted, boys unassisted and girls unassisted categories.
- (d) Ribbons fourth sixth to be presented to the individuals finishers in the boys assisted, girls assisted, boys unassisted and girls unassisted categories.
- (e) Ribbons to be presented to the first place team in the assisted and unassisted categories (maximum five).
- (f) Ribbons to be presented to the second place team in the assisted and unassisted categories (maximum five).
- (g) A team trophy to be presented to the first place team in the assisted and unassisted categories.

10. <u>DEPORTMENT</u>

(a) Competitors and coaches are expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner as per Article XVI, Section II, Deportment, of the ROPSSAA Constitution.
